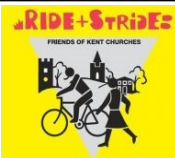


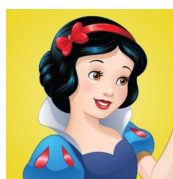
Welcome to today's Worship—make sure you take a copy of the latest Diocesan Magazine: Together
