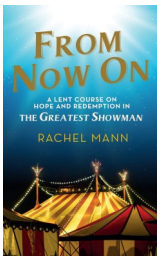


Welcome to the churches of Holy Trinity today

Electoral Roll Revision

The 'Electoral Roll' is a Church of England list of those aged 16 or over who consider themselves *members* of their local church. It is revised every six years and even if you have previously been on the Electoral Roll, you will need to complete a new application form this year. You can only vote at the Annual Parochial Meeting (April 28th) if you are on the new list and the number of people on the Roll is reported annually to the Diocese and links to our representation on Deanery Synod. Our Electoral Roll Officer, Mike Wareing, will be making application forms available shortly and they need to be returned to him by 6th April
